Notes for JOHN JACKSON BAXTER:

John Jackson Baxter enlisted in the 6th Regiment, CSA Florida Infantry on May 02, 1862 at the Apalachicola Arsenal. The unit had 31 officers and 511 men, and soon moved to East Tennessee. He was captured on September 8th 1862 in Tennessee. On September 16th 1862 he was released in a prisoner exchange. He was then furloughed on October 1st 1862 and returned to his unit. Upon return his unit was assigned to Colonel R.C. Trigg and General Finley's Brigade, (Army of Tennessee). This Brigade served on many battlefields from Chickamauga to Atlanta. He saw action in Tennessee with Hoods and ended the war in North Carolina. This regiment reported 35 killed and 130 wounded at Chickamauga and in December, 1863, totalled 214 men and 133 arms. only a remnant surrendered in April, 1863. He was paroled at Greensboro, North Carolina on May 1st 1865.
